1. DEMONSTRATION OF VARIOUS POLYPHASE TESTING.
2. ELECTRONIC METERING AS THE "WAY OF THE FUTURE"
3. TOUR OF THE LABORATORY AND DEMONSTRATION OF I&M CALIBRATION TECHNIQUES.
4. DEMONSTRATION OF TRANSFORMER TESTING ON METERING TRANSFORMERS.
